silent letters

There are many last consonant silent letters in French. The final letter 's' is silent in the words 'habitats' and 'bras'. The 't' is silent in the words 'et' (almost like the English sound 'eh'). The '-nt' is silent in the 3rd person plural conjugations of the verbs 'habiter' and 'pousser' (habitent and poussent)
