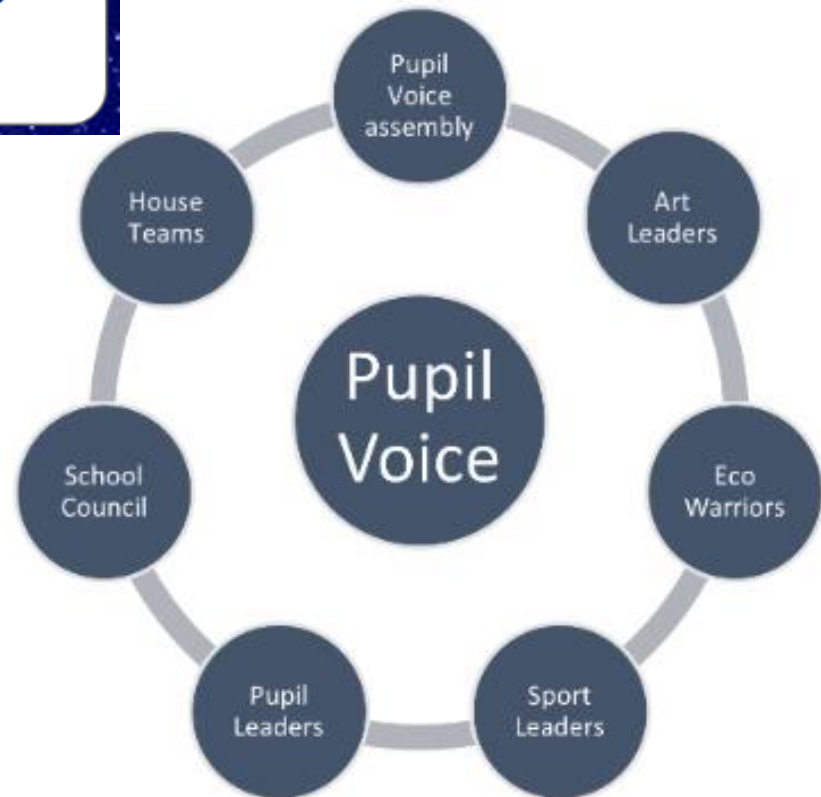

- Reading comes first!
- School and WGC library visits
- Little Wandle Letters and Sounds revised
- Daily whole class reading sessions
- Individual readers - at least three times a week
- Books are changed regularly from both class and school library.
- All children heard read through a variety of different ways throughout the day everyday.
- Join us every Friday morning to read with your child in the classroom (8:35-8:50am)

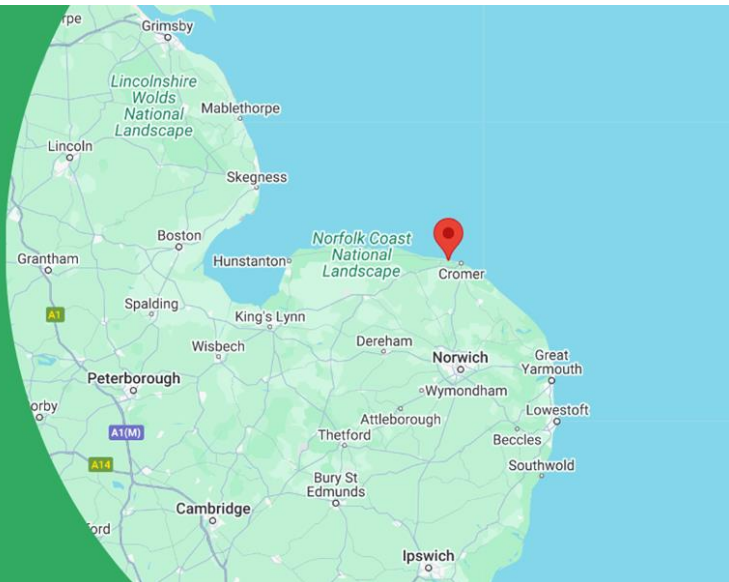
